Thank you for your support over the last week. As you may be aware, the government have been updating their guidance on a daily basis. This has meant that as a school community, we have had to adapt and change to meet this.

This week we will roll out our rapid flow tests and I do hope that I have your support and consent to carry this out in order to keep risks as low as possible for our small community.

To support this, we start this week with Y11 and Y10 students starting on Monday 11th January, and Y9, Y8 and Y7 following shortly after on Wednesday 13th January.

In light of the new variant of COVID, we are working extremely hard on our remote learning offer and this will be placed on our website every evening, ready for the next day. We use Bramble, and a guide to how to use Bramble will be posted online too.

The government have scrapped exams for a second year and will once again use teacher assessment for grades. Therefore, it is extremely important that students attend the virtual lessons (or on site) to allow our teachers to have enough evidence to make an informed assessment.

If teachers have not seen a student on their remote lesson, they will be liaising with the Skills Coaches who will be calling you every day to discuss absence, and following our standard safeguarding procedures. Keep safe and keep in touch.
